St Nicolas' Church Taplow Southside Appeal

Since the publication of our 2014 Quinquennial Architectural Report, much of the identified "Urgent" structural work has been successfully completed.

The two projects of greatest structural concern were:-

1. The North Roof, North Rainwater Goods and North Wall project, which was funded in part with generous support from our friends and neighbours, was completed early in 2016.
2. The Church Tower Parapet project was completed in 2017.

One area of significant structural concern remains: the south side of the church – our "Southside" project.

The challenges are:-

1. The South Roof, where tiling has failed in places potentially allowing some of the main roof beams to get wet.
2. The South Rainwater Goods, which are at the end of their life and are now causing structural and potential structural damage in places.
3. The South Wall, which is crumbling and shedding masonry due to its age and failure of the South Rainwater Goods.

It is these challenges for which we are now launching our Southside Appeal and are seeking support from our congregation, our friends and our neighbours to help raise the £75,000 needed for this project.

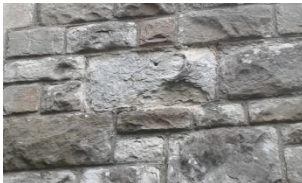
